Since 1921, tens of thousands of nonprofit professionals have attended Institute sites across the country to learn how to build stronger organizations, better serve their members, and become leading business advocates.

Each year, 1,000 nonprofit professionals come together at five sites across the country for a weeklong program designed to instruct, inspire, and invigorate. Institute’s curriculum focuses on the unique challenges facing associations and chambers today, from membership, recruitment and retention to legal issues, to budgeting, new media, advocacy, and marketing.

Graduates of the four, weeklong sessions receive the IOM recognition, signifying 96 hours of course instruction in nonprofit management. Additionally, the curriculum is tied to the CAE and CCE professional industry certifications.
